

## CORK Care & Cleaning Guide

Cork features Cleangene technology. Cleangene is a stain inhibiting polymer inherent to the material make-up. Unlike topical treatments it does not wear off. Cleangene enables the use of strong cleaners such as undiluted Isopropyl Alcohol and high concentrations of bleach, and a variety of other industrial cleaners. With Cleangene, virtually any tough stain (such as ballpoint ink) can be removed.

Prompt cleaning is always recommended. Recommended cleaning steps are listed by type of stain.

<p><b>Regular Cleaning and Maintenance</b> Clean the soiled area with mild soap and water, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry with a clean cloth.</p>	<p>Dirt Dust Grime</p>
<p><b>Food Stains / Oils</b> Wipe affected area with a soft cloth or soft bristle brush using a non-abrasive cleaner, for example Formula 409 or Fantastik. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.</p>	<p>Ketchup Chocolate Coffee Tea Juice</p>
<p><b>Healthcare</b> Clean the soiled area with a 20% solution of Household Bleach and water. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the bleach solution.</p>	<p>Blood Urine Betadine Disinfectant</p>
<p><b>Difficult Stains</b> Clean the soiled area with 50% solution of Isopropyl Alcohol (Rubbing Alcohol) and water. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the alcohol solution.</p>	<p>Eye shadow / Mascara Lipstick Crayon Grease Mustard</p>
<p><b>Ink Stains</b> To successfully remove ballpoint pen or marker, it is important to clean the stain immediately. Rub the marked area with Undiluted Isopropyl Alcohol (Rubbing Alcohol). It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water promptly after applying the alcohol.</p>	<p>Ballpoint Pen Permanent Marker Paint</p>
